

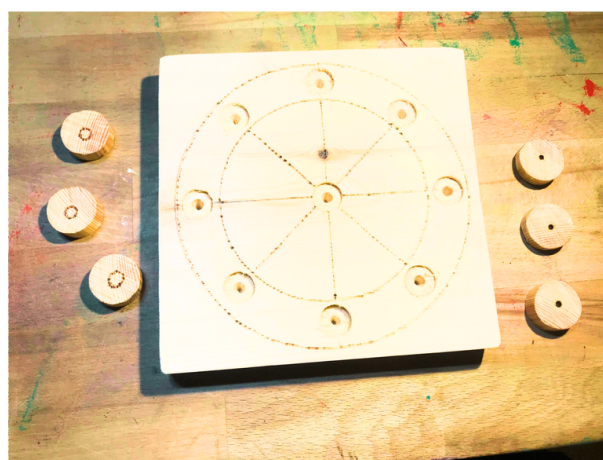


'Rota' means 'wheel' in Latin. Carvings of Rota have been found in Roman and Greek towns.



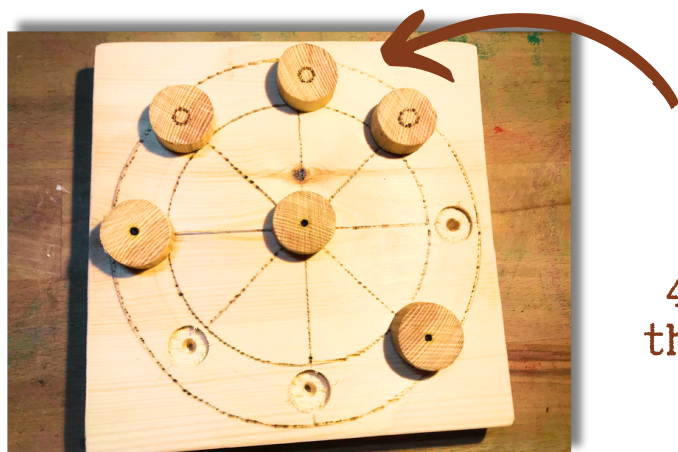
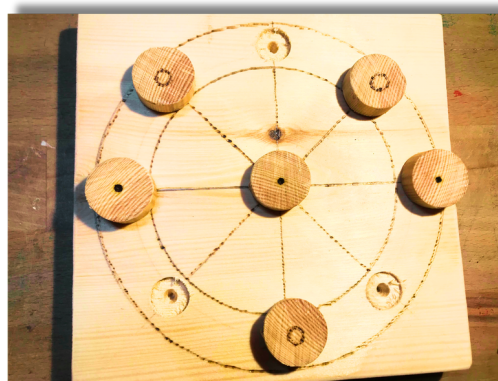
Rota board carved on the ground in the Roman Forum at Leptis Magna, Libya.

1. Take it in turns to place one piece at a time onto the board.



2. Once all the pieces are on the board a player can move one piece each turn.

3. A piece can move along any straight line or curved edge to an empty space. No jumping!
